Material: Polypropylene suitable for direct food contact. This component has been designed for the purpose of re-heating liquid food products in a domestic microwave in line with the cooking instructions and safety guidelines. Suitable for domestic freezing. However, care must be taken when handling when frozen. Suitable for industrial chilling however care must be taken when handling. Recommended maximum fill temperature 85°C. Higher filling temperatures maybe achievable, dependent upon product filling process and downstream equipment.

This product is designed to have a minimum fill level of 10mm below the lid. A larger head space may result in panelling of the side walls or increased risk of lids popping. However this is dependent upon recipe, filling process and downstream equipment.

Packing: 40 units per case

Stacking: Maximum 1 pallet high. Customers should make internal trials to determine the viability of stacking and transportation once filled.

Quality: Deviations in the product specifications of 0.025% (i.e. 25 items per 100,000) are considered acceptable in the industry and therefore cannot be construed as defect.

Works orders including full traceability information will be held for a minimum period of twelve months from the date of manufacture.
